2009 Senior Baseball Local Rules

Senior Level First Season Rules and Regulations

1. OSAA High School regulations apply. Junior Baseball Organization, Inc., American level rules should be enforced. This includes field dimensions, pitchers mound, and length of bases.
2. Pitching rule shall be as follows: Pitchers shall be allowed to throw no more than four (4) innings per game and have a total of seven (7) innings per week (Monday - Sunday constitutes a week).
3. Teams will bat all players on the roster; substitution in the field shall not change batting order.
4. Players shall receive a minimum of at least three (3) innings per game of playing time. This is subject to the Managers discretion.
5. Double Header special rules:
 - A. Pitchers shall throw no more than four (4) innings in a day. Any combination of innings between the two games is acceptable.
 - B. Minimum playing time should follow regular game procedures (3 innings per game).
6. Six (6) innings shall be observed in a "Double Header" scenario.

Senior Division Team Draft and Team Makeup Rules:

K.Y.S.A. reserves the right to place Coaches with Managers as to evenly distribute adequate coaches for all teams. Managers and Coaches should be placed on teams before the Draft.

Teams will be re-drafted annually through an evaluation process. Managers will select their draft order through a "by chance drawing of numbers". Serpentine order should be observed as to promote an even distribution of players through the teams.

Player agents will be responsible in placing any players over the 12 standard players on a given team.
