

KYSA TOURNAMENT RULES

Thank you for participating in KYSA's Invitational Tournaments. The following rules will apply during all our regular season tournaments.

- 1 All teams will be expected to follow applicable age and grade requirements for Junior Baseball of Oregon that apply in their particular division.
- 2 Each team will be required to turn in a complete team roster before their first game; This team roster should include: name of team, name of player, number, birth date, and grade; you may forward these rosters to tournamentdirector@keizeryouthsports.org before the start of the tournament if you wish. Once submitted, no changes will be allowed to the roster.
- 3 **No team may "play down."** Teams which are registered with JBO must play their level or above. No players registered on an official JBO roster may play below the Division that they're registered in.
- 4 The outcome of any protests will be determined by the Tournament Director; this decision will be final.
- 5 The Tournament Director (or assistants on site) and Umpires will have the authority To remove any coach, player, or spectator from any game if the behavior is not appropriate and consistent with JBO's rules of conduct. Managers will be responsible for the conduct of their team's parents.
- 6 Pitching regulations by division are as follows:
 - Midget (state tournament pitching regulations will be followed)
A youth must not pitch more than six (6) total innings per consecutive games. In Addition, a National level youth is limited to three (3) innings per game.
 - Juniors
A youth must not pitch more than seven (7) total innings per consecutive games. In Addition, a National level youth is limiter to four (4) innings per game.
 - Senior & Cub
A youth must not pitch more than eight (8) total innings per consecutive games. In Addition, a National level youth is limited to four (4) innings per game.
- 7 At the senior level only; no new inning may start after 2 hours and 15 minutes with the exception of the championship and third place games. On midget and Junior games, no new inning will start after 2 hours. In the event of a tie, a winner will be determined by reverting to previous inning scores until a winner is determined. If tied every inning, a coin flip will determine the winner.
- 8 Full rosters will be batted per JBO rules.
- 9 The 10 mercy rule will apply, with the exception if the championship game.
- 10 Coin flip before each game will determine the choice of home and away; the onsite Coordinator will conduct the flip; the team traveling the furthest will call.
- 11 A brief infield warm-up will be allowed if time permits between games.
- 12 The following tie-breaker rules will apply in pool play for determining placement games: head-to-head, least runs given up per inning (average based on innings played), coin flip.
- 13 All other JBO regular season rules will apply unless specifically stated otherwise here, including "5 run rule" for National levels.

14 Each home team will be required to supply a person to keep the official book for the game.
